

Marj Briginshaw TAA 1952 – 1983



Marj Briginshaw was born in Brighton where she lived for most of her life and attended school at Methodist Ladies College in Elsternwick.

After several jobs, Marj joined TAA where she worked in the Salaries and Wages Section of the Finance Department.

This was in the 1950s and Marj was the comptometrist and the only female in the small room. Marj worked in the Salaries and Wages Section for a great many years with occasional stints in Papua-New Guinea where she relieved staff for their annual leave.

At TAA, Marj was greatly involved with the social side especially that of the Finance Department. The Finance Department held raffles every pay day and put on two big functions each year, the *End of Financial Year Party* and the *Christmas Party*. For many years, Marj was the driving force behind these functions. Staff from other departments used to clamor for invitations to these functions, which became legendary, with lots of great fun, wonderful food and drink.

Marj attended TAA's 50th birthday anniversary function in 1996 which was held at the RACV Club in Melbourne.

When Marj reached 80 years of age she decided to give up driving and not long after, she moved from her home in Brighton to the retirement home, Cumberland View, on Wellington Road in Mulgrave.

Marj died at the age of 89 in 2015 quietly and peacefully. A lovely lady and a great TAA person.
